We will be sending out this half-term's school council newsletter today. Every half-term the school council run a special assembly. This is an opportunity to present a topic to the school and all the children have the opportunity to discuss it, vote on it and then see the impact of their decision making. This half-term the focus was choosing our school charity. The school council members discuss the outcomes with school staff, the school governors and they produce a newsletter to go home to parents and carers. The children on the school council come from our Y6 class. Every child in the class has the opportunity to be on the school council for a term. We think this is a very fair approach as every child gets the opportunity to have the role during their time in Y6. The school council also have their own page on the school website.

**Attendance** The school's attendance target for all the children is 96.1%. The attendance figure for the school this academic year up till 06.10.17 was 96.8%. Improving attendance was our only action point from the last OFSTED inspection – especially for the very small number of pupils who are persistently absent (below 90%). It is therefore very pleasing to see the good attendance rates that we have started the year with. We will continue to monitor attendance very closely and reward good attendance with prizes, medals and certificates. Every Friday the children in the class with the best attendance from the week before all get a prize to enjoy. You can see which classes received it in the table below.
