We held our parent evening meetings on Tuesday and Wednesday this week. We would like to say a big thank you to all the parents and carers who were able to attend. The children have really enjoyed reading the lovely comments that you left for them about their English and maths work. If you were not able to attend the parents' evening but would still like to see the class teacher then please get in touch with school and we will arrange an appointment time. Unfortunately, we had to cancel the Y1 appointments because Miss Sapple was not well. However, she is now back in school and we will be arranging a new parents' evening time for all the Y1 parents and carers to meet with her. Details will be sent out about this next week.

Attendance The attendance for the school (without the nursery children) this academic year up till 3.11.17 is 97.2% which is a great figure. We sent out the attendance certificates for autumn term one today. We are very pleased to have 121 children in our 100 club with 100% attendance – well done to all of them. There were also 43 children with attendance over 95% who got a green certificate. The children whose attendance was below 95% received an amber letter and the children with attendance below 90% received a red letter. We will not authorise any absence for a child whose attendance is below 90% without medical evidence of their illness.
