Christmas Shows

We will be giving out tickets for all the Christmas shows next week. There is a limited amount of seating in the school hall for each production so entry is by ticket only. The date and time of the shows is on the ticket, on the school website and on the list of events in this newsletter. They will all be taking place in the school hall.

Christmas Jumper Day

Christmas Lunch

On their party day the children will be able to wear party clothes to come to school. We are asking for a donation of a £1 cover the cost of the party food.

These will take place on Monday 18th December. The Y1, Y2 and Y3 children will have their disco between 4 and 5pm. The Y4, Y5 and Y6 will have their disco between 5.15 and 6.15pm. The cost is £2 (payable on the door) and this includes sweets, crisps and a drink.

The Last Day – Wednesday 20th December

This will be a very special day with our panto and toy day taking place. In addition the children can wear a Christmas hat to come into school if they want to.

Christmas Panto

The panto this year is Sleeping Beauty. It will take place on the last day of term. The children in the Reception class, the infants and the juniors will be able to see it. We are asking for a donation of £2.70 to cover the price.
