We have introduced the Golden Mile activity to the infant and junior children in assembly this week. The first classes to try it are going to be our Y6 and Y3 children. We hope all the infants and juniors will be taking part by the end of next week. The aim is to get every child moving for the last ten minutes of lunchtime every day. They will make their way around a trackway on the school yard. How they get around is up to them. They can choose to walk, jog or run. At the end they record the number of laps that they have done. Twenty five laps around the track equals a mile. So as the days and weeks go by we can see just how far they have all gone. We will be giving out special Golden mile certificates as they reach 10 miles, 25 miles, 50 miles and 100 miles! The aim is to promote health & fitness and get the children engaged in daily physical activity.
