Nursery Curriculum Leaflet Autumn Term Two

Subject	What we will be learning about			
English	The children will be continuing their phonics journey this half term and will be learning the following sounds: d , t , i , n , p and g , as well as reviewing previously taught sounds (m , a , s). They will also be developing their fine motor skills to help them use pencils and other one-handed tools with more control.			
	Our Favourite 2 stories for this half term are 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and 'Burglar Bill'.			
Maths	In maths, the children will have lots of counting practice, making sure that their numbers are in the correct order. They will be learning to recognise numerals, initially 0 to 5, and matching quantities to these numerals. The children will also be introduced to the concept of measuring length and will be using words such as <i>longer and shorter</i> .			
Communication and language	Children will be developing their listening and attention skills through listening games, stories and circle time. The children will be immersed in lots of new vocabulary around the topics of Autumn and Celebrations.			
Expressive arts and design	The children will be exploring colour and colour mixing this half term. When Christmas gets a little closer, they will have the opportunity to create lots of Christmas crafts. They will also be learning Christmas songs in preparation for their Christmas performance in December.			
Understanding the world	The children will be learning about different celebrations including Christmas and Diwali. They will also be exploring all things <i>Autumn</i> . They will be noticing the changes we see during Autumn and exploring natural objects that can be found during Autumn.			
Physical development	There will be lots of activities in the classroom provision aimed at developing children's fine motor skills such as threading, weaving and colouring,			
RE	In our RE sessions, the children will be learning the Christmas story and thinking about why Christmas is an important time for Christians.
