

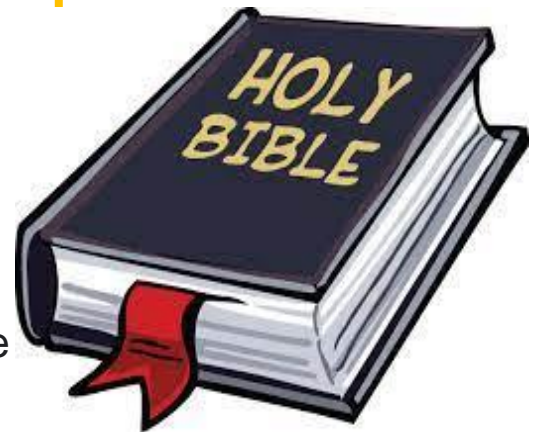
CHRISTIANITY - 'What does it mean to be a Christian?'

What do Christians do to show their beliefs at Church?

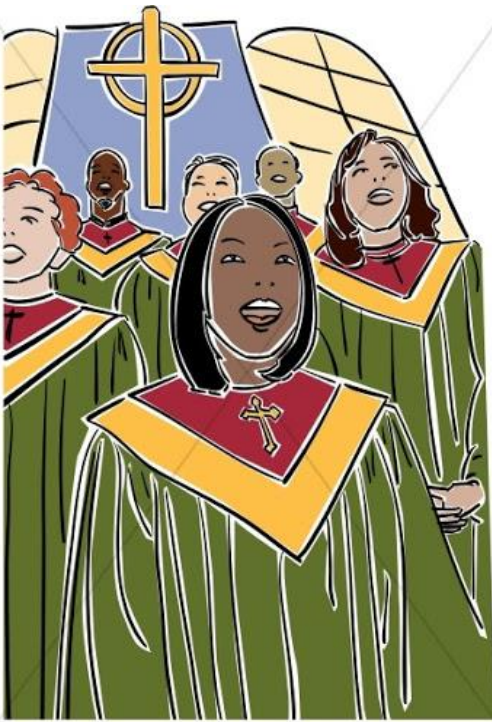
Harvest – 'And don't forget to do good and share with those in need - Hebrews' 13:6

God	The creator of the world
Christian	A person who follows the religion of Christianity
Holy Bible	The Christian scriptures or holy book
Cross/Crucifix	A Christian symbol of salvation and resurrection
Jesus	The son of God whose teachings are the basis for Christianity
Salvation	The protection of Christians from harm and sin
Resurrection	The rising and rebirth of Christ from the dead
Psalms	A sacred song or hymn from the book of Psalms
Eucharist	Christian church service commemorating the Last Supper, in which bread and wine are consecrated and consumed.
Vicar	A person who is in charge of a church and the religious needs of people in the area
Church	A building used for public Christian worship
