10	<p>General points that were made include:</p> <p>COMMENT: 'My son loves coming to school each day and loves to tell me about all the things he has done.'</p> <p>COMMENT: 'I think Wardley is an excellent school and has a passion for learning.'</p> <p>COMMENT: 'Never have any concerns – school seems great.'</p> <p>COMMENT: 'She has never felt unsafe whilst attending school.'</p> <p>COMMENT: 'My child has made excellent progress whilst at school'</p> <p>COMMENT: 'Any issues have always been dealt with immediately by the class teacher'.</p> <p>COMMENT: 'I am really pleased with my child's education and the support from the school.'</p> <p>Areas for development include:</p> <p>COMMENT – A comment was made about a class not having an end of year trip.</p> <p><i>SCHOOL ACTION – The aim is for every class to have at least one trip or visit to support the children's learning during the coming academic year. The aim of the trips that the children are taken is to enrich and deepen the children's learning. As such they are timed to support particular topics and can take place at any</i></p>			

*point in the year. Parents and carers will be informed of each class trips through the half-termly newsletters,*

COMMENT – A suggestion was made that there could possibly be more homework.

*SCHOOL ACTION – The homework schedule is looked at each year. We believe the homework tasks of daily reading and learning times tables & spellings for the weekly tests are crucial. We are introducing a new reading journal which will give the children much more scope for recording their thoughts about their reading. Again we see this as a core part of how working at home can reinforce their academic progress. In addition we will be having a focus each term on learning poetry by heart which is now a key part of the English curriculum.*

COMMENT – A comment was made that the signposting for how and when school information is sent out could be made clearer.

*SCHOOL ACTION – A new school website will be launched in September 2016 which will hopefully help parents and carers to access school information even more easily. The different ways that school information is sent out will also be signposted in the weekly newsletters.*
