










Subject	We will be learning about
Writing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Simple retelling of a narrative • Character descriptions • Recount from personal experience • Poetry
Reading 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our core texts will be Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl • The book centres around Mr Fox, who lives with his wife and four little cubs. To feed his family, he steals food from the hideous farmers named Boggis, Bunce and Bean. Frustrated by being outwitted by Mr Fox, the story revolves around their attempts to capture him. • We will look at prediction, sequencing, retrieval and we will explore links between texts.

Geography 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fieldwork and Map Skills • Study a Small Area of a Contrasting Non-European Country looking, in particular, at the Yanomami people and rainforests. The Yanomami people are an indigenous group who live in the Amazon rainforest. They are known for their close relationship with the rainforest environment, which plays a crucial role in their culture, economy, and survival.
