Writing	 Sit correctly and hold a pencil correctly. Say first and then write to tell others about ideas. Re-read writing to check it makes sense.
Reading	 Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words. Listen to and discuss a wide range of texts. Predict events.
Maths 6159	Our units in maths are: • Numbers to 10 • Number Bonds to 10 • Addition within 10
Art	 Make marks using a variety of tools Organise and arrange marks according to techniques used Apply knowledge of mark making
