I am also in conversation with the Heads of Y7 about those children who may benefit from additional support with their transition to the high school.

Please be assured that the high schools are very conscious of this difficult period and are thinking about how they can best meet the needs of every student. Once the government have made some challenging decisions and once schools know how best we can accommodate this situation, please be assured that the transition of the Y6 pupils is very high on the priority list.
